



Site Layout Information

The following information has been prepared to help you lay out your site correctly and safely. Please read it carefully and make all those responsible for putting up tents aware of it before they start to save them the hassle of having to start again!

This is, however, only an example of how you could lay out a site, so your actual plot will look different.



Rules

You will need to leave a 2m fire gap between all camping tents (canvas to canvas distance). A 3m fire gap must be left around all cooking tents and caravans.

Leave a 1.5m boundary around all sides of your church plot (this is shaded in grey on your map).

You will see a blue electricity symbol on your map. Please place your marquee, or tent that you intend to have lights installed into, next to this symbol. Failure to do so may mean being put to the end of the installation list and therefore not getting your lights installed as quickly as you'd like. If you have any concerns as to the placement of the electricity symbol on your map, please contact us immediately so that we can resolve the problem before we get on site. Your willingness to cooperate will really help us to distribute lighting effectively and quickly.

Please note:

- To help you find your plot there will be a label on the ground near the road, showing your church name and ID.
- You will see that the 1.5m boundary around the edges of your church plot has been shown in grey, and there is a 1m grid on the remaining camping area to help you plan your site.

- If you informed us of your marquee dimensions in advance we have done our best to allocate a plot which will fit it well. We've suggested a location which we think will be best for your marquee, based on experience of laying out plots at Newday. You're not required to put your marquee where we suggest, but please remember to adhere to the rules above about fire gaps and power points for lighting.
- Around your plot there may appear to be 'free space', which is shaded grey. Please do not use this space for your own purposes. These areas have been left unallocated for specific reasons. If, once you have arrived on site, you are still having difficulty fitting onto your plot please speak to your Zone Host so they can assist you.
- If fire gaps are not adhered to, you will be asked to reposition any tents, caravans, marquees, etc. which breach these regulations. We enforce this, not because we want to be a pain, but because we value people's safety!
